Rules of Play are governed by 1860 National Association of Base Ball Players as adopted on March 4th, 1860

All Clubs Guaranteed 3 Matches

Each match is 7 complete rounds or 1 Hour and 15 minute Time Limit.

Note: If Club bats in the top of the 7th round and is ahead, the bottom of the 7th will be played regardless of time limit.

Tie breaker 1 Least Tallies Allowed

Tie breaker 2 Head to Head Competition

Championship Match will be a full 9 rounds with no time limit

Juneau BBC will get Umpires, however if this doesn't pan out we will either play on our honor and have someone on-site volunteer

Note: If you have those willing to be Umpires, we can accommodate so they still get to watch their club play.
